SUMMARY OF BURNING REGULATIONS

TYPE OF BURNING

LEAF BURNING

April 1 – May 31

Oct. 1 - Nov. 30

Thursday and Sunday (excluding national holidays)

10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

LANDSCAPE WASTE

Jan. 1 – Dec. 31

Sunday thru Saturday

(7 days a week – excluding national holidays)

12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Please follow safety regulations when burning.

- All fires shall be continuously attended by an adult of eighteen (18) years of age. No fire shall be allowed that is reasonably determined to pose danger to the safety of any building, structure, or nearby trees.
- There shall be a readily available source of sufficient water to extinguish the fire.
- All burning is prohibited when wind exceeds ten (10) miles per hour.
- NO fire shall be set or permitted within twenty-five feet (25') of any building or structure.
- ANY FIRE EMERGENCY DIAL 911
- NO burning of boxes, plastic and household waste is allowed in the Village.
