### Discussion of Village Garden Walk

The Commission would like to recruit an additional person for the committee. Trustee Mark Vandenbergh will take a more visible picture of the nominated tree at 517 Shady Lane. Village Forester Susan Allman stated the Village has had other pine trees nominated for Tree of the Year and complimented the tree.


