Public Comment

There was no public comment.

Approval of Minutes from August 6, 2024 Environmental & Health Commission Meeting

Motion by Steve Kahn and seconded by Lauren Preisen to approve the August 6, 2024, Environmental & Health Commission Meeting Minutes. On roll call vote Chairperson Aylward, Steve Kahn and Lauren Preisen voted AYE. No NAYS. Motion Carried.

Discussion of Village Garden Walk

The Commission agreed the Village Garden Walk held August 25, 2024, was a success and well received by the community. Chairperson Aylward thanked member Steve Kahn for his efforts organizing the event. It was agreed that the 2025 Village Garden Walk would be held in June when participants' gardens are less dry than in the end-summer months. Coordination with the Honey Lake Bee residents was popular as well. The Commission will begin recruiting participants earlier in 2025.

Discussion of 2024 Tree of the Year

There are presently two nominations for the Village 2024 Tree of the Year program. Lauren Preisen will follow up with last year's nominations that were not selected as 2023 Tree of the Year in case they would like to be nominated again. The Commission will extend the deadline to November 5, 2024. The nomination committee is made up of Stacey Laschen, Lauren Preisen and Kourtney Sellers. The Commission would like to recruit an additional person for the committee. Trustee Mark Vandenberg will take a more visible picture of the nominated tree at 517 Shady Lane. Village Forester Susan Allman stated the Village has had other pine trees nominated for Tree of the Year and complimented the tree.

Standing alone on the corner of Shady Lane and Orchard Road, it presents larger, taller, and more majestic in shape and form when viewed driving up Shady Lane, down Orchard Road, or when one stands beneath it. Many of the residents who regularly walk their dogs by it, stop to gaze up into the branches. It has housed squirrel nests, a crow nest, and a hawk nest over the years. A mulch of its rusty colored old pine needles rings its trunk. It is a rare stand alone, White Pine in North Barrington with great site lines for all residents as it sits on the corner edge of the property.
